






"BIENVENUE EN FRANCE" A NATIONAL ATTRACTIVENESS STRATEGY LAUNCHED

➤ Several measures aimed at attracting more international students in French HEI – 500 000 by 2027

The 'Bienvenue en France' Label



Awarded to higher education institutions that develop and promote welcome services for international students



151 institutions awarded Bienvenue en France



65% of international students in France are registered in a certified institution









THE GOVERNANCE OF THE 'BIENVENUE EN FRANCE' LABEL

A Sterring Committee

- Define the objectives
- Meets twice a year

The labelling commission

- Certification of higher education institutions
- Five assessors
- Meets three or four times a year

A dedicated team of 4 people within the agency

A pool of experts made up of 72 external experts









THE 'BIENVENUE EN FRANCE ' LABEL GOAL

- Inform international students (L&M) about reception conditions and provide a guarantee of confidence
- Provide a framework for evaluation and generate a positive approach within the higher education sector to improving the quality of the welcome services
- Highlight the initiatives of institutions and serve as a tool for raising their profile
- Increase the attractiveness of our higher education institutions by demonstrating the positive approach initiated by France

The label's expertise is based

- On a framework that has been built around the student experience
- By consulting students to get a better understanding of their needs
- 6 chapters and 28 indicators









LABEL FIGURES

First edition 2019-2022








Second edition 2023-2028

- Institutions sign up again for the 2nd edition










