Why Internationalization in Teacher Education?

DAAD program lehramt.international

"Germany's prospective teachers work in an increasingly globalized environment. International experience and intercultural knowledge help them to teach well in this context."

"Preparing young people for international labor markets and responsible action in global contexts should begin at school. Teachers must be able to relate to global developments and their impact on society against the backdrop of their own experiences and convey them in an authentic, subject-related way. It is therefore important to ensure that teacher training has an international focus. This includes both curricular content and formats as well as subject-related and practical stays abroad. Increased international components can also help to make teacher training itself more attractive for prospective students."

"Prospective teachers should be enabled to deal with international diversity and cultural diversity in German schools."

"A new DAAD publication shows that a semester or school internship abroad strengthens the skills of student teachers, which are of great importance in everyday school life in Germany."

Challenges for Internationalization in Teacher Education

- Highly regulated study contents
- Highly regulated study programs
- Content oriented towards (sub)national education plans
- Current lack of teachers in German education system
- → Relatively low rate of international mobility among Teacher Education students
- \rightarrow Relatively low rate of recognition within international mobility

Internationalization of Teacher Education at University of Education Weingarten (UEW)


Strategic Development Plan 2022 – 2026 of UEW

"As part of its mission statement, UEWhas stated in the Strategic Development Plan 2017-2021 that it promotes the worldwide exchange of students and lecturers. It aims to make a sustainable contribution to international and intercultural understanding within the university and between universities and the surrounding society. This objective is pursued with regard to students (incoming and outgoing) as well as lecturers and administrative staff, taking into account and using innovative possibilities of digitalization. In the future, UEW graduates will work in increasingly heterogeneous educational contexts. Internationalization helps them to perceive and reflect on heterogeneity and to experience a change of perspective, and it enables them to deal competently with increasing heterogeneity in educational professions."










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Framework: Internationalization of Teacher Education @ UEW

- Funding by: German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD)
- Time frame: Two project phases, 2019-2022 and 2023-2024
- Seven partner Universities (Universidade de Santa Catarina Florianopolis/Brazil, Universidad de Concepcion/Chile, Majaraja Sayajirao Unibersity baroda/Indien, Sakhnin College for Teacher Education/Israel & Universidad de Leon/Spain, George Mason University/USA)



Goals: Internationalization of Teacher Education – ILaP & ILaP+

- Establish and expand a partner university network
- Facilitate, foster and standardize student exchange
- Establish Digital Mobility to provide a variety of mobility formats to cater to diverse student needs and interests

Establishing Digital Mobility activities

- Building on experiences during pandemic
- Creating a support structure for English medium and online teaching
 - 4-day workshop at the UEW for planning joint virtual teaching events and further support of lecturers for virtual teaching
 - Financial travel support for lecturers to prepare VTC
 - Student assistants to support preparation of English-language online teaching material
 - Coaching provided by experienced lecturers

Digital Mobility Activities: Outcomes

- By 2024: 14 DMAs in different formats, expected to reach 500+ students
- 42 ECTS points
- Connecting beyond initial project network
- Creating synergies with Erasmus+ KA131 and other Erasmus+ projects
- → Digital Mobility Activities one element for diversification of more sustainable mobility portfolio providing internationalization opportunities to diverse target group, working in combination with: Semester exchange, Internships, Research stays, short-term programs (Summer Schools etc.), Module Mobility in Lake Constance Area.

Challenges for Digital Mobility

- Connecting People
- Initial investment / Funding opportunities
- Additional tasks for lecturers and IOs
- No statistical validation

→ Need for increased structural support and recognition of Digital Mobility!
